Traffic Technologist Two Regular Full-time Positions

As a key member of the Traffic Operations team, you will report to the Traffic Operations Engineer:

Position 1 – Traffic Signal Technical Support: The main focus of this position will be the operation, maintenance, rehabilitation and upgrading of street lighting and traffic signals which will include contract administration and summer student supervision. The position will also involve street light and traffic signal design, review and construction inspection. Your duties will involve assisting with the identification and prioritization of projects and prepare project descriptions and conceptual sketches for submissions. You will be responsible for supervising and/or conducting traffic studies in response to requests from the public and for City projects with traffic consultants and city staff involved with development reviews. Familiarity with Synchro and Sim Traffic will be considered an asset. **Competition #CITE2010-100634.**

Position 2 – Traffic Operations Public Liaison: The main focus of this position will be to investigate requests and complaints from the public, organize and conduct traffic studies, draft technical reports, and recommend solutions. You will be responsible for managing the traffic data collection program, reviewing geometric designs, modeling signal operation, preparing capital project applications and training and supervising the work of one or more part-time employees. Familiarity with traffic micro-simulation and strong verbal and written communication skills to effectively communicate with the public are essential to your success. A working knowledge of traffic operations and safety as it relates to all modes of travel will be considered an asset. **Competition #CITE2010-100660.**

You will have a diploma from a recognized technical institute in an appropriate discipline with emphasis in the traffic/transportation field. Certification or eligibility for certification as an Applied Science Technologist within the Province of BC along with a valid Class 5 BC Driver's License is required. The ideal candidate will have considerable knowledge of signal operations and principles; knowledge of traffic operations; the ability to work in a team environment and a desire to help us achieve our mission "To serve the public interest through leadership, innovation, and a focus on community priorities and strengths".
